



Guidelines and requirements for 4th and 5th grade students registering for Chorus:

- 1. Complete the attached Chorus Registration Forms, due August, 29th. The first rehearsal is on August 20th.
- 2. Chorus is scheduled to meet for both grade levels on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 am to 8:25 am in the music room. Please make every effort to be on time. I will make allowances for late buses and car riders. Attendance is required at regular rehearsals and evening performances. No more than 3 absences (excused or unexcused) from regular rehearsals in one semester will be allowed in order to participate in a program or field trip. Written excuses for missing a performance are required.
- 3. The chorus will perform a winter and spring concert as well as concerts for the community. Details for these performances will be made available in future parent letters and on my website (<u>www.marshpointmusic.weebly.com</u>). **Students in chorus are expected to perform at every concert.**
- 4. In order to maintain a uniform appearance of the group, chorus students are expected to wear a white polo shirt, navy pants, dark socks, and dark shoes for field trips and Sunday best clothes for winter and spring concerts. Girls may choose to wear a navy skirt with navy knee highs or tights in place of navy pants.
- 5. Each student will be expected to consistently complete academic work: both classroom work and homework. Classroom teachers may withhold a student from rehearsal to work on incomplete assignments. This is considered an unexcused absence. More than three unexcused absences may result in dismissal from chorus.
- 6. Since participation in the chorus is an honor and a privilege, students are expected to set an example of self-discipline and self-control for others to follow. Failure to comply with the Savannah-Chatham Conduct Code may result in dismissal from chorus.
- 7. Consistent school attendance is expected. A student who is frequently tardy, absent, or leaving early from school may be held from participation in chorus to spend necessary time on classroom work. If a chorus student is absent from school the day of an evening performance, he/she will NOT be expected to perform that evening.
- 8. Students may need to pay a small transportation fee for performances away from school.
